These are the five tunes you should know by heart before the first test. "By heart" means:

1. You can sing them with lyrics.
2. You can sing them with solfege syllables
3. You can sing them with with rhythm syllables.
4. You can sing them while conducting.
5. *Ideally, that you can play them on keyboard or other instrument, but this is not required.*
6. Using your mastery of (1) - (3) above, you can notate them in any key, both
 - (a) without key signature, using individual accidentals as needed, and
 - (b) with a key signature.
7. You can re-notate them with ssany beat value, for example, a 2/4 tune in 2/2.

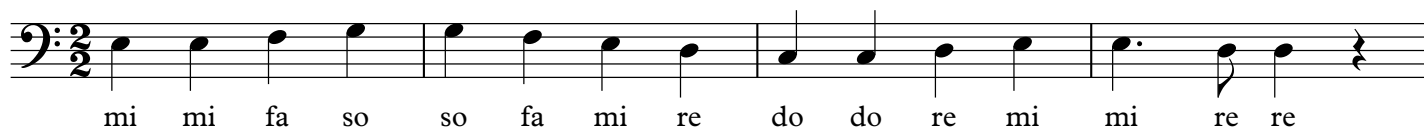
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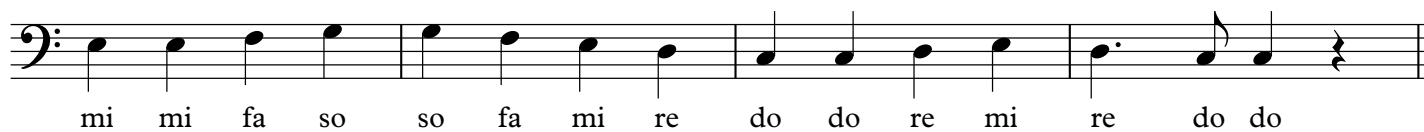
