## MU 209: K 550 score reduction and analysis

Below is the beginning of a keyboard reduction of mm. 1-17 of K. 550, movement 1.

It is a **complete** reduction up to m. 9: <u>every pitch</u> in the score is indicated, including octave doublings. It is not the most **playable** reduction, for that reason. A reduction intended for piano performance would omit certain doublings. But accompaniments may still be simplified rhythmically without leaving out any harmonic information. For ex., the opening viola eighth notes are represented as whole notes in the reduction.

## Assignment Part I:

- A. **Complete** the reduction below for mm. 10-17
- B. **Provide** roman numeral analysis for the entire passage, mm. 1-17.

News you can use: "Corno in B alto" means "French horn in B, high". It transposes down a whole step. "Corno in G" means "French horn in G". It transposes down a perfect fourth.

"Clarinetti in B" means "clarinets in Bb". They transpose down a whole step.

- A. Make similarly complete reductions of mm. 44-51 and the parallel passage in the recap, mm. 227-233.
- B. **Provide** roman numeral analysis for both passages.
